The Reno Jazz Orchestra has been based in Northern Nevada for over 25 years and was formed by musicians who performed and traveled the world with acts such as Frank Sinatra, Sammy Davis Jr., Elvis Presley, Natalie Cole, Luciano Pavarotti, and other legendary performers. The tradition of jazz excellence set by the founders continues today with jazz professors, educators, and graduates from the University of Nevada, Reno's jazz studies program setting new performance standards.

### 2022 Educational Programs

RJO's Education Programs, directed by Nichole Heglund, are increasing their scope, breadth, and outreach. This year's expansion includes the addition of the Reno Youth Jazz Orchestra (RYJO) to its already robust educational endeavors.

Jazz in the Schools This marked a return to an inperson event with 15 local school ensemble performances and over 250 students performing. This year, in partnership with the UNR big band and Reno Youth Jazz Orchestra, the Friday event provided professional development sessions to UNR music education students and local directors.

Saturday Jazz Workshops Directed by Dylan Coleman-Tunstall, this intimate and engaging program focused on jazz improvisation, ear training, and rhythm. The workshop program included four sessions and 18 students during its twice-offered 8-week program. The highlight was seeing them perform as they opened for two RJO shows. ### 2022 Educational Programs (continued)

Mentor Program The Reno Jazz Orchestra Mentor Program completed its twelfth year of supporting jazz education in our area schools. This program sends professional jazz musicians and educators to local schools to work on improvisation, jazz style and instrument-specific techniques. Our 2022 program statistics include the involvement of 17 RJO Mentors and 130 sessions at 18 different schools. Thanks to supporters like you, the RJO provides mentors at no cost to the schools.

Lessons Program RJO piloted an after-school lessons program at a local Title I middle school in Spring 2022. Students received 16 hours of instruction in a small group setting. This vital outreach gives students from low-income families the opportunity to receive additional instruction to improve their skills at no cost. In the Spring of 2023, we will expand to offer individual and small-group lessons at local Title I schools.



### Reno Youth Jazz Orchestra (RYJO)

This year was an exciting one for us as we merged the Reno Youth Jazz Orchestra into our organization.

RYJO is the vehicle for big band performances for student age youths with ensembles that perform throughout the Northern Nevada and Northern California area

The RYJO season begins with auditions and the selection of the band members in October, with rehearsals beginning the first week in November. RYJO conducts, on average, twelve performances during their nine-month season. Additionally, five former RYJO members perform regularly with the RJO.

Their first performance as part of the RJO was for the 2022 Holiday Jazz Jubilee.



This year, we charged ahead to record our 7th album that features current and former RJO members. Unique compositions from Chuck Reider, Dr. Larry Engstrom, Hans Halt and Julien Knowles were the focal point of this project. We could not have done this without Tom Gordon and his team at Inspired-Amateur Productions for their professionalism and commitment to excellence. We expect the release of Creative Directions in Jazz sometime in 2023.




