History & Mission

The Reno Jazz Orchestra has been based in Northern Nevada for over 25 years and was formed by musicians who performed and traveled the world with acts such as Frank Sinatra, Sammy Davis Jr., Elvis Presley, Natalie Cole, Luciano Pavarotti, and other legendary performers. The tradition of jazz excellence set by the founders continues today with jazz professors, educators, and graduates from the University of Nevada, Reno's jazz studies program setting new performance standards.



Year in Review

This past school year was a remarkable success for RJO's Education Programs. Students received 350 hours of instruction through various initiatives, including the Mentor Program, Saturday Jazz Workshop, Lessons Program, Reno Youth Jazz Orchestra, and the Jazz in the Schools event. Our dedicated team of 45 instructors provided music instructional support to over 900 youth.

Discover Jazz Workshop

An exciting change this spring was the move to the Note-Able Music Therapy Services building. With the addition of a dedicated RJO classroom, the spring semester of the Jazz Workshop, held on Saturdays, welcomed 15 students from 12 local schools. The students improved their ear training, jazz theory, and improvisation skills



with talented instructor Dylan Coleman-Tunstall and guest instructors Nick Bentz, Vincenzo Pellegrino, and Tyler Cravines. The semester ended with a dynamic performance at Laughing Planet, where students could utilize their skills alongside professional musicians and the Reno Youth Jazz Orchestra combo.

Jazz in the Schools

The 25th annual Jazz in the Schools event, held at the University of Nevada, Reno, on February 10th, saw a record attendance of 425 student musicians and featured 18 school ensemble performances. The University of Nevada, Reno jazz faculty offered both beginning and advanced improvisation clinics. Students had the invaluable opportunity to work with trombonist, composer, and educator Dean Sorenson, as well as talented musicians Anisha Rush, Barb Catlin, and Gary Mayne.

Lessons Program

Now in its fourth semester, RJO's Lessons Program continues to serve local Title I schools, offering students from low-income families the opportunity to receive additional instruction at no cost. This year, RJO partnered with Traner Middle School and Wooster High School, providing over 140 hours of individual and small group music lessons during the school day with the help of 11 local instructors.

Mentor Program

The Reno Jazz Orchestra Mentor Program completed its 13th year, continuing its mission to support jazz education in local schools. Professional jazz musicians and educators guided improvisation, jazz style, and instrument-specific techniques. This past school year, 14 RJO Mentors conducted 110 sessions at nine different schools, all at no cost to the schools, thanks to the support of our donors.




Expense Summary July 2023 through June 2024
